Spokane County Shelters

American Red Cross shelter at Spokane Convention Center

This is the main evacuation shelter for residents. Food, cots and basic emergency assistance have been reported. Small pets are welcome, and parking is free.

Spokane County Fair & Expo Center — RV and animal evacuation area

The RV grounds are open for evacuees with animals. Arrivals have been instructed to use the red gate off Broadway. This location primarily accommodates RVs and animals rather than serving as a general indoor shelter.

The Barking Lot — animal sheltering

This location has been reported as an animal evacuation shelter. Call before arriving to confirm available space and which types of animals can be accepted.

Stevens County Shelters

Jenkins Jr./Sr. High School — Red Cross shelter

Kettle Falls Middle School — Red Cross shelter
