## Advanced Training in Gender Affirming Care – Level 4

**Audience:** Medical providers who have been in practice 60+ days

Building on Foundations of Gender Affirming Care Levels 1 - 3, this quarterly workshop is designed for medical providers who have been delivering direct patient care to gender diverse adolescents and adults for at least 2 months. Content includes advanced prescribing guidelines, dilemmas, nuances, touching on puberty blockers, surgical preparation and recovery support, and internal referrals to Chase Brexton patient resources. The main focus of the workshop is an exploration of medical care considerations through more complex case scenarios, including examples, challenges, and questions shared by participants.

This is an advanced training course meant for medical prescribers only. To take this training, you must first complete Fundamentals of Gender Affirming Care Levels 1 - 3 and have completed at least 60 days of clinical practice involving gender affirming care.

## Foundations of Gender Affirming Surgery Assessment for Behavioral Health Providers

This workshop is intended to prepare behavioral health providers to appropriately assess clients seeking Gender Affirming Surgical procedures through the World Professional Association of Transgender Health (WPATH) standards of behavioral health care for gender diverse individuals. Participants will review common psychosocial concerns, behavioral health needs, treatment goals, ethical considerations, surgical-candidate assessment and advocacy in gender affirming care and will become familiar with best practices in composing surgery recommendation letters. Finally, learners will explore the integrated care role of behavioral health clinicians in surgical-candidate assessment and support.
